About the exhibit:




All Ages Jazz Jam

Expressions of violence seem to be ever-present these days. But what if there were another way? A better way? What if we could generate world peace with the flip of a switch? Futurity, the new folk-rock musical by César Alvarez and The Lisps, imagines such a world. At the height of the Civil War, a soldier named Julian Munro joined forces with inventor and mathematician Ada Lovelace to invent the machine that created peace. It is a story about the power of imagination combined with ingenuity and the importance of dreaming up the

impossible. This hit show enjoyed an extended run by popular demand when it first premiered and proposes that music and storytelling are the machines that might create peace.
