A free pop-up art showcase

Aurora, CO - A collection of performing art groups, restaurants, and visual artists are joining forces to highlight East Colfax's Aurora Cultural Art District with "Devour The Arts," a free art showcase.

On Nov 10th from 7 pm - 9 pm at The People's Building, we will host Devour The Arts in The Aurora Cultural Arts District. Devour The Arts will feature tasty bites from area favorites like <u>Urban Burma</u>, <u>Báhn & Butter Bakery and Cafe</u>, <u>Miette et Chocolat</u>; visual art from <u>Charlo Garcia</u> & <u>Red Delicious Press</u>; films from students at <u>DAVA</u> (Downtown Aurora Visual Arts); and performances from a diverse set of performing groups including <u>Vintage Theatre</u>, <u>Au' Malama Polynesian Dance Arts</u>, <u>Pop Up Theatre</u>, <u>Act One Productions</u>, <u>Nueva Escuela De Música</u>, and <u>The Daryl Gott All Ages Jazz Jam</u>, among others. Guests will eat, drink, and mingle while performances "pop up" throughout the evening.

This November is the event's second year (the first was pre-covid). Residents, organizations, and businesses are excited to showcase the influx of artistic and cultural activity. The event is free to the public. There is also a free public parking lot behind the venue.

Artist Call

The Aurora Cultural Arts District seeks original, 2-Dimensional artworks by artists from Aurora and the surrounding metro areas. The exhibition will showcase artistic excellence in the city by bringing cultural values and traditions passed down from previous generations. We seek diversity in materials, subject matter, and artists and the stories they are telling. The objective is to tell the untold stories of the many cultures and immigrants through visuals while enhancing Aurora's cultural identity.

The theme is "Cultural Reflections" to highlight our community's cultural heritage.

This initiative aims to diversify our public art collection by exhibiting and selling artwork from artists in all stages of their careers. The project is open to all artists residing in Aurora and the surrounding metro area. Although this initiative is open to all artists, special consideration shall be given to artists who identify as members of a Native American tribe or are a refugee.

About the artist:

Charlo is a multimedia artist and designer who strives for one thing: joy. Through symbols, letters, and lines, his monochromatic two-dimensional works are a space for exploration and discovery. Hidden themes and messages reside in the densely packed compositions, allowing viewers to impart their sense of meaning from the works or be delighted by the meanings provided by the artist. The interwoven shapes, words, and symbols foster a sense of community interaction, collaboration, and hopeful optimism. Having emigrated


from Monterrey, Mexico, in 2013, the Denver-based artist describes himself as filled to the brim with gratitude. In his native language of Spanish, the equivalent for "experiencing joy" is "alegría," and it is this experience of joy he wishes to share with the world through his works. The deceptively simple yet dense paintings and drawings are reminiscent of influential artists such as MC Escher, Keith Haring, and Remedios Varo. His communal collaborations between spectator and artist began in Denver with his Make Alleys Great Again project, in which the artist appropriated the slogan of a politically divisive U.S. politician to bring unity and joy to communities. By using the NextDoor app, the artist connected with fellow residents of the greater Denver community who invited him to paint murals onto their garage doors. The artist brought local art to more than four dozen alleyways. Since his Make Alleys Great Again project, the artist has continued to make a name for himself. In 2021, he produced a live mural entitled The Joy of Being Together in partnership with NextDoor and the New York Stock Exchange. The artist's joyful, optimistic, and communityoriented work continues to gain interest on a national level.

EVERY LAST SUNDAY; 1-3 PM



Join Aurora Dance Arts for "Are We In Kansas, Yet?"


This show is our unique twist on the classic story of The Wizard of Oz. Join Dorothy as she twirls in the tornado to a magical land over the rainbow, where



The exhibition is free and open to the public **Monday to**Friday, from 10 am to 5 pm, through November 11th.




