


## **Cadillac Crew**





## **Black Nativity**

#### December 1st-3oth

Black Nativity, the joyous holiday musical, is a modern retelling of the traditional account of the Nativity story from an African-American perspective. Using gospel music, African beats, dramatic dance, and a biblical narrative Black Nativity opened for a limited run of 57 performances at Broadway's 41st St. Theatre on December 11, 1961. It was written and conceived by one of the legendary leaders of the Harlem Renaissance: Black playwright, poet, novelist, and social activist Langston Hughes.

As a follow-up to the previously announced **"Fox Interlude"** fall line-up of events, we are thrilled to announce Season 39, which will run from Jan. through Dec. of 2024.

The new season at the Aurora Fox will begin with the quick-witted comedy, "ART" by Yasmina Reza, playing Feb. 3 to 25, 2024, in the Studio

Theatre. Hailed as one of the most successful comedies of all time, "**ART**" is the winner of the Tony Award (Best Play), Olivier Award (Best New Comedy), and NY Drama Critics Award (Best Play).

The second production of the season will be August Wilson's "Gem of the Ocean," playing from March 23 to April 14. A 2005 Tony Award Nominee for Best Play, "Gem of the Ocean" is the first in Aurora Fox's commitment to producing August Wilson's ten-play "The American Century Cycle". Boasting multiple Tony Awards and Pulitzer Prizes for Drama, the cycle follows the lives of Black Americans throughout each decade of the 20th century.


In June of 2024, in partnership with Aurora Public Library, the Fox will present the family-friendly fantasy adventure, "The Lightning Thief: The Percy Jackson Musical" playing June 1 to 23. With over 180 million copies sold, "The Lighting Thief" is based on Rick Riordan's best-selling fantasy novels, sprung to life with dazzling special effects and a riveting pop-rock score.

In another library partnership, fall brings the classic Jules Verne adventure, "Around the World in 80 Days" adapted by Mark Brown, playing Oct. 5 to 27. Traveling by boat, train, and elephant, Phileas Fogg and his trusty valet, Passepartout, set the timer on a riotous and suspenseful race-against-the-clock romp around the globe.

The final production of the season, playing Nov. 30 to Dec. 22, is the regional premiere of "Ebenezer Scrooge's Big Christmas Show!" written by Gordon Greenberg and Steve Rosen, based on "A Christmas Carol" by Charles Dickens. Wacky fun for the entire family, five nimble actors play dozens of roles in this hilariously fast-paced and highly imaginative Dickens mashup.

The upcoming Aurora Fox season will go on sale in September of 2023, but discounted season FlexPass tickets can be obtained with purchase of a VIP ticket for the Fox Jubilation & Fundraiser event on **Sunday, September 10th, 2023**.




## **CJRO**


## **Shelvis and the Roustabouts**

Start the season of giving with original art by DAVA Youth and local artists. DAVA is a wonderful destination for handmade holiday gifts! Proceeds from this exhibition support DAVA's free year-round art programs for kids in our northern Aurora community. DAVA is located at 1405 Florence Street, one block south of East Colfax Avenue in the Aurora Cultural Arts District.

Students in all DAVA programs are creating unique artworks and colorful everyday items to share with you. Inspired by guest artist and DAVA staff member **Leya Admasu**, high school students painted colorful patterns layered with subjects inspiring peace and harmony. Students of all ages carefully crafted a wide range of ceramic items, including animal planters with succulents, clay whistles, pitchers, vases, coffee accessories, and textured wall tiles. Other students are painting and weaving colorful bookmarks, felting animals, and designing greeting cards.


Artwork by guest artists includes unique paintings mixing tribal patterns and realism by Ethiopian-born artist **Leya Admasu**, block prints by **Raymundo Muñoz**, and handmade prints on fabric towels and bags by **Jen G Studios**. Wooden ornaments, wall hangings, and vases by **William Emerson** and jewelry by **I Love ME Gems** add to the selection. Martin McDonagh's first play (In Bruges, Three Billboards Outside Ebbing, Missouri, and The Banshees of Inisherin), The Beauty Queen of Leenane is a 1996 dramatic play by Martin McDonagh which was premiered by the Druid Theatre Company in Galway, Ireland. It also enjoyed successful runs at London's West End, Broadway and Off-Broadway.

It was nominated for a Laurence Olivier Award as Best Play for the London production, and the 1998 Broadway production was nominated for six Tony Awards, winning four, for Best Leading Actress in a Play, Best Featured Actor in a Play, Best Featured Actress in a Play (Anna Manahan), and Best Direction of a Play. This production is a reading from one of the area's best actors. Proceeds with benefit

the local charity, Denver Actor's Fund.
